

Health Kits for Haiti

Asbury United Methodist Church is collecting items to make health kits to send to Haiti. The health kits will provide basic necessities to people who have lost everything.

Each kit requires the following items:

- 1 hand towel (15" x 25" up to 17" x 27")
- 1 washcloth
- 1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket-sized)
- 1 nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery boards or toenail clippers)
- 1 bath-size bar of soap (3 oz. and up)
- 1 toothbrush (single brushes only in original wrapper, No child-size brushes)
- 6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages

You can bring these items on:

- Sundays, there will be a box in the Narthex
- Saturday, March 6 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Monday through Friday, March 8 to 9 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Saturday, March 13 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Volunteers are needed to assemble the kits on March 13 at 1:00 p.m.
